About the Results

Each month Blackbox conducts interviews with a representative sample of 1,000 Singaporeans.

We use a geographically stratified online sample. Our methodology also applies quota controls to ensure representative demographic coverage of the population. The Government Satisfaction Index for July stayed stable at 76 points. Most notable increases in July were housing, racial relations/integration and cost of living.

Public transport registered a drop of 5 points compared to June which likely links to the news coverage of SMRT trains being shipped back to China for repair. While still significant the drop is less sharp than the reactions to the massive breakdown in July 2015 which caused a 12 point drop in satisfaction.

Looking at the 12 month trendline, the Government is falling back across four key areas: education, government accountability, wages/salaries, and the gap between the rich and the poor.
